Amphibians.

Amphibians are ecotothermic, anamniotic, four timbed vertebrate animals that consitiute the class Amphibia. In its broadest sense, it is a paraphyletic group encompassing all tetrapods excluding the amniotes. All extant amphibians belong to the monophyletic subclass Lissamphibia with three living orders: Anura, Urodela and Gymnphiona Evolved to be mostly semiaquatic, amphibians have adapted to Inhabit a wide variety of habitats, with most species living in freshwater, welland or terrestrial ecosystems. Their life cycle typically starts out as quatic larvae with gills known as tadpoles, but some species have developed behavioural adaptations to bypass this.


your amphibians generally undergo metamorphosis from an quatic larval form with gills to an air-breathing adult form with lungs.







Aquatic Organisms

An aquatic animal is any animal, whether vertebrate or invertebrate, that lives in bodies of water for all or most of its liketime. Aquatic animals generally conduct gas exchan -ge in water by extracting dissolved oxygen via specialis -ed respiratory organs called gills, through the skin or ocross enteral mucosae, although some are evolved from terrestrial ancestors that re-adapted to aquatic environments, in which case they actually use lungs to breathe air and are essentially holding their breath when living in water, some species of gastropod molluge, such as the eastern emerald sea slug, are even capable of kep toplastic photosynthesis via endosymbiosis with ingested yêllow-green algae. Almost all aquatic animals reproduce in water, either oviparously or viviparously, and many species routinely migrate between different water bodies during their life cycle. Some animals have fully aquatic life stages while as adults they become terrestrial or semiquatic after undergoing metamorphosis.





Insects

Insects are hexapod invertebrates of the class insecta. They are the Largest group within the authropod phylum. Insects have a chitinous exoskeleton, a three fart body, three pairs of jointed legs, compound eyes, and a pair of antennae. Insects are the most diverse group of animals, with more than a million described species, they represent more than half of all animal species. The insect nervous system counsists of a brain and a ventral nerve cord. Most insects reproduce by laying eggs. Insects breathe air through a system of paired openings along their sides, connected to small tubes that take air directly to the tissues. The blood therefore does not carry oxygen. It is only partly contained in vessels, and some circulates in an open hemocoel.





The leader claims rights to the female langures in the group and the genetic make up of the future generation of monkeys. Other males in the group may lay claim to it only as long as they do not challenge the leadership. Sri lanka purple faced langurs communicate using loud calls.

Kangaroo.

Kangaroos are marsupials from the family Macropodidae. In common use the term is used to describe the largest species from this family. the red kangaroo, as well as the antilopine kangaroo, eatern grey kangaroo, and western grey kangaroo. Kangaroos are indigenous to Australia and New Guinea. The Australian government estimates that 42.8 million kangaroos lived within the commercial harvest areas of Australia in 2019, down from 53.2 million in 2013.

As with the terms "wallaroo and wallaby kangaroo refers to a paraphyletic grouping of species. All three terms refer to members of the same taxonomic family, Macropodice, and the smallest are generally called "wallables". The term "wallaroos" refers to species of an intermedicate size. There are also the tree kangaroos, another type of macropod, which inhabit the topical rainforests of New guinea, far northeastern Queenstand and some of the islands in the region.
